


#### Luke 24:44-53

<sup>44</sup>Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you — that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled." <sup>45</sup>Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, <sup>46</sup>and he said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, <sup>47</sup>and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup>You are witnesses of these things. <sup>49</sup>And see, I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

50 Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. 51 While he was blessing them,

he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. <sup>52</sup>And they worshiped him, and returned to Jerusalem with

great joy; <sup>53</sup>and they were continually in the temple blessing God.

#### **Marshall Church Council Meeting Minutes**

#### April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014

The Marshall Church council met for its regular meeting on April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014. Present were: Pastor Jeremy Johnson, Dale Himebaugh, Darrell Gordon, Andrew Sprau, Rhonda Hatle, Carie Hanson, Craig Hanson, Luvern Hanson, Gary Kulow, and Karina Mensink. Absent were: Gus Johnson and Jerry Sprau.

The meeting was called to order by Dale. The Secretary's report from March was read. Carie gave the Financial Secretary's report. Total offering for the month of March was \$5030.30. Cause of the Month offering was \$157.30. Luvern gave the Treasurer's report. Expenses were reviewed and Gary made a motion that the reports be accepted as read with Craig seconding the motion. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: May cause of the month will be the Teen Homeless Shelter Lutheran Social Services is working on in Rochester. Discussed the roof again. A bid has been received from Southland Construction for \$25,000. We are going to look at some projects to see what gauge steel we want and what style. Look at going over the existing roof or tear it off. Several new ideas for memorial money were presented, a table for the back door or a table for pastor up front so he can face the congregation. The garbage pickup is on hold until we need it and then we will try "Y" disposal. The youth packed food in Austin and there was about \$500 left if kids or families want to go back.

NEW BUSINESS: Pastor is looking for ideas for the Maundy Thursday service if anyone has any thoughts. The Religious release programs will be hosting a program on May 4<sup>th</sup> at 5:00, "May the 4<sup>th</sup> be with you" and will serve a meal for those who come. Becky Hartwig is in charge of the meal if you want to donate bars or help.

Gary made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Rhonda seconded. The motion carried.

The Little Cedar Lutheran Church Council met on Wednesday, April 23, 2014 @7:30pm. Members present: Karen Anderson, Gordy Briggs, Becky Hartwig, Pat Hinz, Joe Matheis, Tricia Milks, Rod Nordeng, Mary Schmitz, Tracy Smith, Lani Wolff, Jaymie Poshusta, and Pastor Jeremy Johnson. Members absent: John Jax(in for Jim Johnson), Cathy Roser, and Nancy Smith. The meeting was called to order by Chair Pat Hinz.

**DEVOTIONS/PRAYER**: Pastor Jeremy

**APPROVAL of COUNCIL MINUTES**: A <u>motion</u> was made by Gordy Briggs, <u>seconded</u> by Becky Hartwig to approve the March 2014 Council Minutes, as printed. <u>Motion carried</u>.

**CORRESPONDENCE/RECOGNITION of VISITORS**: A letter was received and read from the Family of Wilma Weness. The family gave \$1025.00 in memorial money, to be used to support and enhance the ministry to seniors and others who are unable to attend church services. Discussion and suggestions followed. A <u>motion</u> was made by Karen Anderson, <u>seconded</u> by Rod Nordeng to do the wiring from the camera recorder (that records the church services) to the sound system. <u>Motion carried</u>. Council will continue to explore more options here.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**: Jaymie recorded a balance of \$7947.43 in the General Fund and \$4410.23 in the Daycare Fund. Jaymie pointed out that the February Energy Bill was \$3185.00, with over \$2000.00 of that going for heating the building. Pat will talk to Jim Schroder about the thermostats and how they are set throughout the building. A <a href="motion">motion</a> was made by Joe Matheis, <a href="motion">seconded</a> by Tracy Smith to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. <a href="motion">Motion</a> carried.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

- A. <u>Building</u>: Joe Matheis reported that 2 of 3 estimates have been received on the roofing project. Kiker estimates \$40,900 for a rubber roof/no insulation. Merit gave 2 estimates: \$79,687 for rubber roof/insulation and \$96,390 for asphalt roof/insulation. Joe is waiting on one more estimate that would include the removal of asbestos, if present in the existing roof. Council set a tentative meeting date of April 30<sup>th</sup>, to discuss all 3 estimates and put together a proposal to present to the congregation for a vote. Announcement of this vote will take place Sundays April 27 and May 4. Voting would take place on Sunday, May 11, following worship. Jaymie presented one possible fundraiser, called "Tree of Life", for members to look over.
- B. <u>Cemetery:</u> Tracy Smith reported that the Directory is soon to be put in place.
- C. <u>Daycare</u>: Linda Gilles reported that the Fall daycare rates were discussed and it was decided to go with a daily rate for children rather than an hourly rate. There will be a summer contract for families that is separate from the school year contract. The committee also discussed setting up a scholarship fund to help Little Cedar daycare family participants, in times of need, with daycare expenses. This fund would be separate from the daycare fund and would be funded through donations by individual donors and possibly using it for the Cause of the Month. Inquiry was made into the Glenda Osmundson Fund, as a possible source for this. Council will look into this further at the May meeting, with more information coming from the daycare committee. Two daycare committee members have volunteered to take over the daycare finance job.

- D. Finance: no report
- E. <u>Life & Missions</u>: Becky Hartwig reported that they met with the service groups. A Religious Release Program will be presented at church on Sunday, May 4<sup>th</sup>. There will be a light meal (free will donation) from 5-5:45 pm with a program to follow at 5:45 PM. A <u>motion</u> was made by Tracy Smith, <u>seconded</u> by Joe Matheis to take money from the Lutefisk Fund to purchase the food for this meal, with the free will donation money to be put back in the Lutefisk Fund. <u>Motion carried</u>. This committee also discussed Blanket Ministry, communion to shut- ins, Cause of the Month, Summer Picnic/Service in the park (with LYO helping those in need of assistance) and get-togethers for young adults in the church. There have been concerns among the service groups of not finding enough workers to prepare the food at funerals. Discussion followed. A <u>motion</u> was made by Gordy Briggs, <u>seconded</u> by Lani Wolff that all funerals held at Little Cedar be catered. Motion carried.
- F. Personnel: Gordy Briggs reported that staff visits were made and went well.
- G. <u>Youth & Education</u>: Pastor Jeremy reported that Confirmation is April 27<sup>th</sup>, First Communion went well, the youth may attend part of the Sonshine festival this summer and the next Youth gathering is in Detroit.
- H. <u>Worship & Music</u>: Pat Hinz reported that Setting 10 will be used for summer worship. There will be Wednesday evening Worship Services in June and July. If attendance is good, they will look at extending it to August.

**PASTOR'S REPORT**: Pastor Jeremy attended a Boundaries Workshop, put on by the Synod. He presented Council with a handout "Establishing Safe Connections: Practical Steps for Pastors and Congregations".

#### **OUTSTANDING BUSINESS:**

A. Pat gave Council the updated Rental Agreement for Little Cedar.

Inquiry made about the parking lot project that was started last summer. Joe Matheis said filling the cracks can be done as that is under warranty with the contractor.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Cause of the Month for May: continue the Ruth DeHoogh Mission work in New Guinea.
