

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> <u>Motion</u> by Millie Weness, <u>seconded</u> by Linda Logsdon that the minutes be approved as printed. <u>Carried</u>.

Correspondence: Thank you notes were read from graduating seniors thanking the congregation for their gifts.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Motion by Bryce Nelson, <u>seconded</u> by Joe Matheis that the treasurer's report be accepted as printed. <u>Carried</u>.

Committee Reports:

<u>Building</u>: <u>Motion</u> by Tracy Smith, <u>seconded</u> by Shari Wagner that we have the cracks in the parking lot filled this year with no seal coat at this time and that we try to get on a four year plan for taking care of seal coating the parking lot. <u>Carried</u>.

Pastor Jeremy was invited to preach at an ecumenical service in his hometown on Sunday, August 21. Council approved his absence here that Sunday.

Outstanding business:

New Business: It was decided to have Weis Landscaping evaluate the shrubs around the buildings for care and possible removal and replacement.
