

Marshall Church Council Meeting Minutes November 6, 2013

Marshall Church council met for its regular meeting November 6, 2013. Present: Pastor Jeremy Johnson, Dale Himebaugh, Darrell Gordon, Brenda Hanson, Andrew Sprau, Gary Kulow, Rhonda Hatle, Gib Seimers, Carie Hanson, Luvern Hanson and Cathy Sprau. Absent: Jerry Sprau.

Dale Himebaugh called the meeting to order.

Pastor Jeremy gave devotions and prayer.

Pastor's report was given. He shared that we will have a guest speaker, Rev. Peter Reuss, Director for Evangelical Missions on Sunday November 17, 2013. Pastor will be gone Sunday, December 29, 2013. It was suggested that we do a hymn sing with Christmas carols and readings, thus would not need a pulpit supply. Discussion on having another "5th quarter" for the youth after a ball game.

Rhonda Hatle read a youth report from Tara Mandt. Pastor Jeremy invited council members to his home for the December council meeting. (December 4, 2013).

Secretary's report was given for the month of October. Financial secretary's report was given by Carie Hanson. Total offerings for October was \$4,110.86. Cause of the month was \$330.36, "Neighbor in Need". Total offerings thus far for 2013 is \$43,846.83. Treasurer's report was given by Luvern Hanson. \$397.44 was paid to Eleanor Gordon for socks for Central Lutheran. Reviewed expenses and current budget. A motion by Gary Kulow to accept reports. 2nd by Rhonda Hatle. Motion carried.

Old Business: The Central Lutheran trip is Monday, November 25, 2013. We are still collecting items for this. Brenda Hanson offered to purchase laundry detergent with the remaining \$30 from the cause of the month fund.

Dale Himebaugh shared that the damaged and loose shingles have been repaired on the roof. Will continue to discuss options for replacing entire roof.

The worship service is being recorded each week and seems to be working OK for now. It was decided to just pass the DVD around at the Health Care Center and Cedar Court apartments for viewing.

Discussion continues on same gender marriages being held at Marshall Church.

New Business: Pastor Jeremy asked the council members if we were interested in doing a new church directory with Little Cedar at this time? After much discussion, a motion by Gib Seimers to do a new church directory with Little Cedar. 2nd by Gary Kulow. Motion carried.

Salvation Army meal will be served November 12, 2013. Eleanor Gordon will take care of this.

Decided to continue to receive "Focus on the Family" inserts for the bulletin.

Dale Himebaugh shared a card with a gift of money from the Ruby Underdahl family. The money will be used for the cemetery.

A motion by Gary Kulow to pay a bill of \$238.31 for a "Neighbor in Need". 2nd by Andrew Sprau. Motion carried.

A request for a large print bulletin to be available for the vision impaired. Also discussed a large print hymnal. Could possibly use money from memorial fund for this.

Pastor asked if the Forty-Milers could be an option for a worship service at Marshall or a joint service with Little Cedar. Council members preferred our own service at Marshall.

A motion by Gary Kulow to adjourn the meeting. 2^{nd} by Gib Seimers. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Jaymie reported a General Fund balance of -\$7976.64 and a Checking Account balance of \$16,549.74. \$20,000 was transferred from the Knutson Fund to the General Fund. Finance Committee will be meeting soon to set the budget for 2014. Jaymie asked council for input on where cuts can be made. Discussion followed. A <u>motion</u> was made by Gordy Briggs, <u>seconded</u> by Bill Klingerman to approve the treasurer's report as presented. <u>Motion carried</u>.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- A. <u>Building</u>: Maynard reported on the parking lot.
- B. <u>Cemetery</u>: Tracy reported that the directory is almost ready to install.
- C. <u>Daycare</u>: no reportD. <u>Finance</u>: no report
- E. <u>Life & Missions</u>: Becky reported that new members will be recognized on Sunday, January 12th, with cake served following worship.
- F. Personnel: no report
- G. <u>Youth & Education</u>: Lyn reported on the Sunday School program "Bethlehem Inn", to be presented December 15th. Pastor Jeremy presented a balance sheet on Vacation Bible School 2013. Total cost was \$383.40.

The synod is beginning something new called the "synod communicator". They would like each church to have a synod communicator, who would be a go between, between the synod and the churches.

A <u>motion</u> was made by Gordy Briggs, <u>seconded</u> by Bill Klingerman to earmark the IBM gift money to be used for the fellowship hall roof. <u>Motion carried</u>.
- C. Church Insurance: discussion on how often payments are made and who is responsible to review the policy when it comes up for renewal.
- D. December meeting: Pastor Jeremy invited council to meet in December, at his home, at 7:30 pm.
- E. Water Heater Rebate: Pat and Kathy will fill out the form to apply for a \$50 rebate on the water heater.
- F. December Cause of the Month: Southland Area Food Shelf.
