Greetings Friends in Christ at Little Cedar and Marshall!

Lenten Greetings! Lent is a season of reflection, renewal, and return. It is a time when we intentionally slow down, turn our hearts toward God, and walk together on the road to the cross. Each year, we set aside these 40 days to examine our lives, seek God's mercy, and be drawn deeper into the grace of Jesus Christ.

One of the ways we do this is by gathering each Wednesday evening for a time of fellowship and worship. I invite you to join us for a simple soup supper at 6:00 PM, followed by our Lenten worship at 7:00 PM using the beautiful Holden Evening Prayer and a series of skits. I always find it meaningful to sing together the Holden Evening Prayer every Lent.

This year, our theme is "Dear Paul"—a series of skits where the Apostle Paul, now in heaven, responds to letters from 21st-century Christians. What would Paul say to us today about faith, suffering, love, and hope? What wisdom might he offer in our modern struggles? Each week, we will explore these questions through scripture, drama, and reflection.

The above reading from 2 Corinthians is a common reading for reflection during Lent. Lent is not just about giving things up—it's about being made new. It's about letting go of what weighs us down and embracing the grace that transforms us. It's about reconciliation—both with God and with one another. So come, bring a friend, share a meal, and worship with us. Let's walk this Lenten journey together, listening for God's voice in scripture, song, and the words of an apostle who still has much to teach us.




FAITH EXPLORERS
