# Mark 12:28-34

<sup>28</sup> One of the scribes came near and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, he asked him, "Which commandment is the first of all?" <sup>29</sup> Jesus answered, "The first is, 'Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one; <sup>30</sup> you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' <sup>31</sup> The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." <sup>32</sup> Then the scribe said to him, "You are right, Teacher; you have truly said that 'he is one, and besides him there is no other'; <sup>33</sup> and 'to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the strength,' and 'to love one's neighbor as oneself,'—this is much more important than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices." <sup>34</sup> When Jesus saw that he answered wisely, he said to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." After that no one dared to ask him any question.

# Marshall Church Council Meeting Minutes April 5, 2017

Meeting was called to order by Gary Kulow.

Meeting post Wednesday Lenten Service with Pastor Jeremy. Note items:

Pastor Jeremy may participate in three day conference, in the cities, for needed Continuing Ed at the end of April. TBD The last couple of months have been very busy with parishioner visits.

#### **Old Business:**

Gary discussed, with contractor, possible warranty of paint job on the steeple. Contractor has offered to touch-up paint when he is in the area this summer.

Forrest received quote from Leif of \$2000.00, for labor, to replace steeple siding. Another \$4K would be needed for delivery and use of a lift for a week.

Either option, for steeple work, incurs \$500 expense to lower wiring allowing for work to be done.

Confirmed that Maundy Thursday service will begin downstairs with 'last supper' communion.

Julie will further investigate options for offering envelopes. Council will revisit next month.

April Cause of the Month - "Neighbor in Need"

#### **New Business:**

Council acknowledges families that are very grateful for use of Little Cedar space for funerals, etc. and wonders if compensation should be provided? Pastor advises that thank-you (rather than compensation) would be appropriate. Card to be crafted and delivered, from the congregation, for this purpose.

Noted that there is likely a need for caulking of windows when weather improves.

Meeting was adjourned by Jerry with second from Larry, closing with The Lord's Prayer.

Present: Pastor Jeremy Johnson, Mike Lamp, Linda Logsdon, Joe Matheis, Sarah Mergen, Bryce Nelson, Lahoma Retterath, Dixie Rose, Steve Schroeder, Janet Stephenson, Shari Wagner, Jan Weness, Millie Weness. Absent: Sherry Schotanus, Susan Ydstie, Nancy Thalberg.

**Secretary's Report:** Motion by Linda Logsdon, seconded by Steve Schroeder that the secretary's report be approved as printed. Carried.

**Correspondence:** A thank you note was read from Marshall Church in appreciation for the generosity of Little Cedar in the use of Little Cedar facilities for funerals and family functions.

-There will be breakfast with the Bishop on Saturday, April 22. Information is available from Pastor Jeremy.

**Treasurer:** Millie Weness noted on the report that there is now a \$12,000 deficit in the general fund. A letter will be sent to all members to help support the budget with contributions to the general fund. Motion by Janet Stephenson, seconded by Linda Logsdon that the treasurer's report be approved as printed. Carried.

#### **Committee Reports:**

<u>Building:</u> Joe reported that the new entry floor mats have arrived and are laid. Gabrielle Smith has completed her senior project by painting the ceiling in the Fellowship Hall. Joe Matheis has one quote for sealing the parking lot. He will get another before a decision is made for completion of the sealing.

<u>Cemetery Report:</u> The committee will meet soon. Steve Schroeder repaired damage done by snow plowing over the winter months.

Day Care: Cecylia Bauer is the new daycare assistant.

<u>Finance:</u> The committee met to determine what to do about the \$12,000 deficit in the general fund. A letter will be sent to all members informing them of the deficit and asking support of the budget passed at the annual meeting in January.

- -Motion by Lahoma Retterath, <u>seconded</u> by Linda Logsdon to cash one of the parsonage \$14,000 CD's and put the money in the general fund. Carried.
- -The Finance Committee recommends taking \$2000 from the endowment fund, which would be matched in equal amount by an anonymous donor and by the Hormel Foundation. This money would be invested in the Austin Area Foundation. The foundation will pay a competitive rate of interest on the total investment of \$6,000. Motion by Steve Schroeder, seconded by Shari Wagner that the council accept the proposal of the finance committee. Carried.

<u>Life and Missions:</u> Little Cedar will celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Week Day School on Sunday, May 21 during the worship service. The celebration will continue after worship with refreshments in the Fellowship Hall.

Youth and Education: Sunday School appreciation will be held Sunday, May 7

- -VBS theme is "Hero Central and VBS" and will be held July 10-14th.
- -Senior recognition will be on Sunday, May 21

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor reported 36 visits and phone calls to families last month plus several funeral visits. He reported 2-3 services per month at the Adams Health Care Center and reading a Bible story and playing with the children in the daycare once per week. He will be attending a two day continuing education event in the Twin Cities next week.

<u>Outstanding Business:</u> <u>Motion</u> by Linda Logsdon, <u>seconded</u> by Sarah Mergen to pay the bill for installation of the eternal flame from the memorial fund. Carried.

<u>New Business:</u> <u>Motion</u> by Lahoma Retterath, <u>seconded</u> by Linda Logsdon that we purchase a new vacuum cleaner with the money coming from the capital improvement fund. Carried.

<u>Motion</u> by Lahoma Retterath, <u>seconded</u> by Sarah Mergen that we purchase a changing table to be installed in the men's restroom and two wood high chairs, one for the narthex and another for the Fellowship Hall, with the money to come from the memorial fund. Carried.

The next meeting is Wednesday, May 15 at 7:30 p.m. Dixie Rose will give devotions. The meeting was adjourned and closed with the Lord's Prayer.
