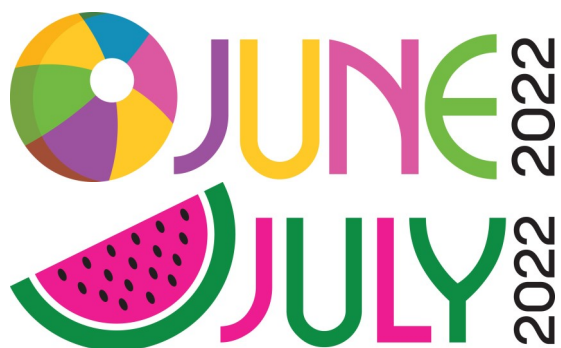

June

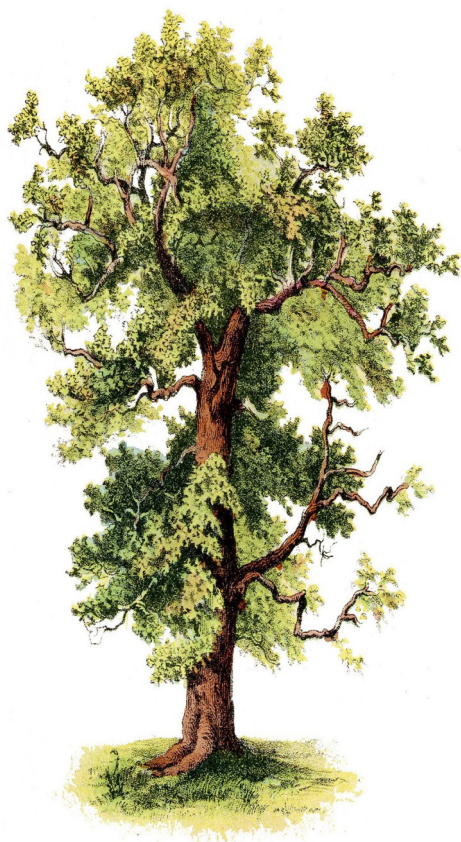

<p>Secretary and financial/treasurer's reports were reviewed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Total offering for April \$4905/\$370 for Neighbor in Need ● May Cause of the Month offering will be for Vacation Bible School. <p>Motion to accept reports from Gary with second from Darrell. Motion carried.</p>
<p>Old Business:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No change to the COVID action plan. ● Projector – TV update: Andrew priced a couple large screen TV's (around 85 inch). They cost between \$2000 and \$3000 with the mounts costing from \$200 to \$500. There was discussion on if one or two screens or TV's would be better. Tabled the discussion at this time ● Gary made a motion to replace the electrical outlets in the kitchen that are not working correctly. Jan seconded the motion and the motion carried. ● The light in the bathroom has been replaced. <p>The area of moisture in a corner of the basement has been cleaned and will be repainted.
